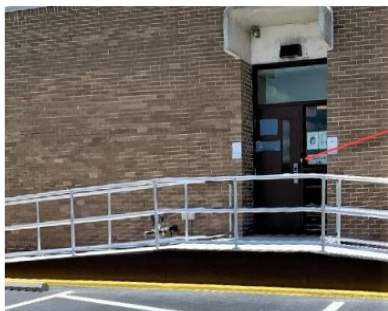
CCCCGC President's Message

7:00 pm General Member meeting was attended by 26 members on site and 8 members via ZOOM.

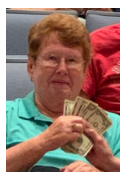

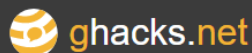
