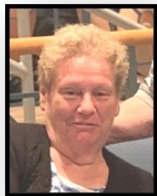

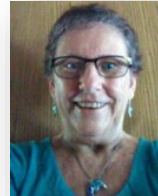

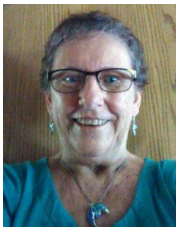

### Google Photos vs OneDrive

Following my article on Google's **Magic Eraser**, I decided to subscribe to **Google One** in the end, mainly to take advantage of the Magic Eraser and all the other premium photo tools available. Some can be used in the free 15GB basic account, but the really cool tools are only available if you sign up for \$2 per month. I ended up with 100GB of space, but that doesn't compare with the OneDrive plan which gives me a massive 1TB of space, which is really the only standout advantage going for Photos on OneDrive.

### Photos On OneDrive

Since upgrading my OneDrive account by subscribing to Office 365 (family deal), it's my go-to place for cloud storage because 1TB is not to be sniffed at. This includes all the photos I take with my phone which I can then download to my PC when required. Bear in mind that the OneDrive sync on PC only stores local thumbnails of images and takes up minimal space, which is a cool feature. However, Microsoft has only recently added the EDIT feature to OneDrive—crop, adjustment, filter, and markup but none of the sexy photo features that Google offers, such as Magic Eraser.

### Google Photos vs OneDrive Continued

That's quite a selection of photo editing features and OneDrive only offers Crop, Adjustment, Filter, and Markup, which are all very dull by comparison. Clearly, a lot of AI is behind these features, and with Microsoft's track record in AI, I'm surprised that the edit feature in OneDrive doesn't offer such premium features.

#### Conclusion

As mobile phones became more powerful, in some cases on a par with low to medium-end PCs – 8GB RAM, quad-core CPUs, etc. – we can take photos and videos on our phones and for me at least, Google Photos offers much more than OneDrive in terms of both features and speed. That's not to say that I will be ditching OneDrive because it's bundled with Office 365, of which it's only a part and I regularly use Word and many of the other applications. However, it would be a pleasant surprise to see Microsoft catch up with Photos, particularly since the company probably already has the infrastructure to do so.

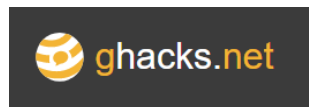
