### Final Thoughts

Windows 10 days are numbered. Support is supposed to end on October 14, 2025. That day is coming fast. Many of us have been hoping that Microsoft would ease the eligibility rules for at least some hardware that would make more computers eligible for a legitimate upgrade to Windows 11. So far that hasn't happened. It's too bad because there are millions of perfectly good computers running in the world that could be become junk should their owners decide to buy a new computer that is 11 eligible. Doesn't seem very environmentally friendly.

What are our options?

- 1. Microsoft will apparently offer some type of paid support for perhaps 3 years.
- 2. There's also another company that will offer paid support for possibly 5 years. The company is called Opatch. They will offer paid support I believe for 5 years.
- 3. Buy a new Windows 11 computer.
- 4. Switch to a new operating system such as Linux.
- 5. Keep using your unsupported computer. It will keep working.
- 6. Have the club update your ineligible Win I 0 machine to Win I 1.

The risk here is that Microsoft may someday decide to shut down computers that are upgraded in that way. They haven't so far.

The next 5 months or so will be interesting. More information to follow.
