

### Tech Info - OneDrive

What is it? OneDrive is a cloud storage service provided by Microsoft that allows users to store, share, and access their files from any device. It functions as a virtual hard drive, syncing files and folders between your computer and the cloud, ensuring your data is accessible wherever you have an internet connection.

By default Microsoft gives anyone signed in with a Microsoft account, 5GB (gigabytes) of free space. More space is available for an additional cost or by subscribing to Microsoft 365. By comparison, if you have a Google account (Gmail account), Google gives you 15GB of free space.

So, what's the problem? In many cases, 5GB of space isn't all that much. If you've been accumulating pictures, music, and videos for many years, you could very easily be over 5GB.

### **OneDrive Continued**

Microsoft would love to have us back up our computers on OneDrive but there are two problems I see with that. First is the space issue, 5GB won't go very far. Second, backing up on OneDrive works if all you're backing up are files like pictures, documents, music etc. If you want a full system backup, you need to use something else. Full system backup is my preference. If my system crashes, I can restore the entire hard drive from the backup. With OneDrive it would be necessary to reinstall Windows and any programs that were previously on the computer and then you could restore your files to the computer from OneDrive.

Microsoft knows that 5GB isn't enough storage for backing up most users but by encouraging you to back up to OneDrive, they are also encouraging you to buy more storage from them. They know what they're doing.

Where you have to be careful is if you delete a file from OneDrive but still want to keep a copy, you better make sure it's saved in a folder that isn't on OneDrive. Otherwise you may accidently delete it completely from both the cloud and the computer. It could be lost. The second video above looks at where files are or are not saved.
