The web browser client will download automatically when you start or join your first Zoom meeting, and is also available for manual download here.



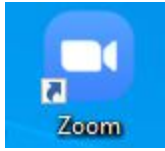

Open your computer and go to www.zoom.com/download and click on the first link to get the client app and install it on your computer. If you have a different platform, like an iPad, scroll down for the correct link for you.

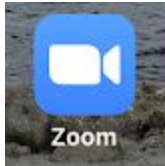


If you have a cell phone, open the Android Play Store or the Apple App Store and locate the Zoom app and install it. It is a free app.

You do not have to download and install it ever again.



On your computer, you will have a shortcut to Zoom on the desktop.



On your cell phone, you will also have a link to open Zoom.
